Quality Coaches

<u>Quality Coaches</u> work with specific caseloads in each Region, and they are your first line of defense for any of your needs. They can assist with STARS paperwork, Continuous Quality Improvement goals, professional development needs, staff development, family engagement, and much more. Quality Coaches work mainly with program directors and owners, and are also available for classroom and teacher support.

When you submit a Coaching Request, your Quality Coach will help determine who is best suited to meet your needs. It may be your own Quality Coach, or another Quality Coach, TA Coach, or Consultant, based on your request.

Technical Assistance Coaches

Technical Assistance (TA) Coaches do not have caseloads and spend their time supporting programs in many different areas, including DAP, lesson planning, behavior challenges, assistance with your chosen internal assessment tool, etc. They also help develop inclusive practices in the classroom for children with special needs. TA Coaches work with directors, owners, and classroom teachers.
